RE: Food Allergies

If a child has an emergency health issue during class, staff are instructed to first call UB Police Department at 645-2222 followed by calling the parent or guardian. Parents may be required to come at any time to pick up a child due to illness or injury.

We would like our teachers to be informed about any potential allergy reactions and request that you complete the Emergency Plan for Students with Food Allergies form and return it to us if you have a child with known food allergies. If your child will be carrying an Epi Pen, please make sure to indicate that when filling out the Emergency Plan. Please make a note in the instructions if you will allow the teacher to carry the form and if you will allow us to post the form where only teachers and staff can see it in UB Learns. Keep in mind that our classrooms are spread out and teachers may not have quick access to this information if it is kept in the office file only.

If any subsequent changes are made to your child's allergy plan, this form should be updated and resent to the GMP office.
