

GMP Computer Access at UB

As a student in the Gifted Math Program, you are entitled to use the academic computer systems at the University at Buffalo. There are two conditions that must be met for a student to use this service.

First, each student must get written parental approval for computer use. Parents must understand that UB does not limit access to the Internet, and must realize that students have full access to the Internet -- both good and bad. To quote from our policies:

"The University at Buffalo does not monitor or generally restrict material residing on University at Buffalo computers housed within a private domain or on non-University at Buffalo computers, whether or not such computers are attached to campus networks."

Secondly, each student must abide by the same policies as all users.
